

Job Description - Teacher

Port Macquarie Steiner School is located in Birpai country on the mid-North coast of NSW. It was established as a Primary School in 2018. Our aim is to provide a welcoming, nurturing and supportive school community for families and others, working with the indications given by Rudolf Steiner.

The position of Class Teacher expects the appointed teacher to remain a central figure through to Class 6. Each newly appointed teacher serves a twelve month probationary period. At the end of this probationary period, there will be an appraisal and review.

QUALIFICATIONS

Required

1. Primary trained teacher with current NESA accreditation.
2. Current First Aid and CPR Certificates from a recognised institution or willingness to obtain them before commencing work.

3. Steiner Education training and/or experience in a Steiner school.

CLASS MANAGEMENT

1. Creates for the students a warm and secure learning environment and an atmosphere of guided purpose out of an understanding of the pedagogical principles and developmental stages and needs of the Australian Steiner Curriculum Framework and NESA.
2. Assist the students to reach a level of readiness for the next developmental stage through appropriate teaching methods.
3. Provide coherent and planned lessons and learning experiences brought with warm enthusiasm and drawing inspiration from Steiner education.

CURRICULUM

1. Present an age-appropriate curriculum through Main Lessons in English, Mathematics, Science, Creative Arts, and HSIE drawing on the Australian Steiner Curriculum Framework to meet the NSW Curriculum and state registration requirements. Other subjects include Languages, PDHPE and Technology
2. Provide regular assessments on the wellbeing and progress of each student to parents.
3. Foster and maintain open, ongoing and positive communication with parents through home visits, Class Meetings and interviews.
4. Organise, care for and maintain classroom space, resources and equipment.

CULTURAL ACTIVITIES

The Class Teacher participates in the cultural life of the school with colleagues through participation in Conferences, Festivals, Open Days, Market Days, News Sheets and concerts, as directed by the College of Teachers.

COLLEGIAL WORK

1. Contributes to the development, documentation, implementation and evaluation of the curriculum.
2. Participates in Faculty and staff meetings.
